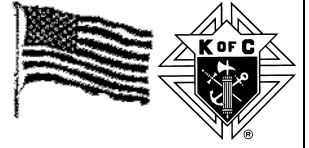

5. Knight of the Month is awarded to Bro. Chad Prejean for leading the cooking team at the District and Area level. Thanks for a job well

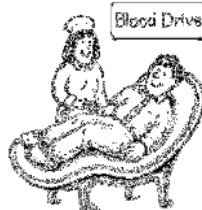
done by our cooking team and representing 1099.
